**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO INVITE PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT ON A COMPREHENSIVE SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS PLAN. THIS PLAN HAS BEEN DEVELOPED TO SUPPLEMENT A DRAFT UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER QUALITY ACT, SECTION 19-5-104 AND 107, UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED.

**BACKGROUND**

The Comprehensive Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP) was developed to meet the requirements set forth by the draft UPDES permit for the Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District (JVWCD). The SAP provides for the routine survey of birds, collection of environmental samples and reporting of concentrations of selenium and mercury in the water, sediment, macro-invertebrates and bird eggs during the nesting season in the discharge channel and delta of JVWCD's proposed Outfall 001 and Kennecott Utah Copper's Outfall 012. Both of these outfalls are located along the south shore of Great Salt Lake in Gilbert Bay.
